Brief Community Announcements and Presentations

District Department of Transportation (DDOT)

1. Downtown BID, Renovation of 7th Street NW, between Pennsylvania Avenue and I Street.
 - Alex Block (Alex@downtowndc.org), Downtown BID, and Megan Kanagy, DDOT (megan.kanagy@dc.gov) discussed potential changes to the areas to improve pedestrian and traffic flow.
 - Commissioner Tinpe made a comment about the planters attracting varmints and we don't want to see an increase in rodents.



2. Call Box Project, Downtown BID seeking multi-medium visual artist to decorate call boxes. Ellen Jones (Ellen@downtowndc.org), Downtown BID discussed the concept to beautify the historical call boxes.

- Commissioner Tinpe asked if the public can see the submissions from the artists. Ellen said yes, it's on their website.
- Commissioner Harrison asked what the \$90,000 will go toward. Ellen provide the breakdown of figures, which was also included in the Commissioners packet. The majority of the expense goes to artist compensation and costs. Additional costs include lead abatement, metal work, administrative and project management costs.
