1.”Lower Area Trunk Sewer Rehabilitation Project” As part of Capital Improvement Program, DC Water will be performing sewer rehabilitation projects throughout the city. It involves the rehabilitation of the Lower Area Trunk Sewer, a 42 inch diameter brick and concrete pipe constructed in 1906 which extends from 13th Street and Pennsylvania Avenue NW to 2nd Street and Tingey Street SE. The rehabilitation includes approximately 12,000 feet (2.27 miles) of 30 inch through 42 inch sewer using cured pipe lining and the repair of 33 sewer manholes.
