

Advisory Neighborhood Commission 2C

**Meeting Minutes - Monday, June 8th 2015, 6:30 pm
Martin Luther King, Jr. Memorial Library
901 G. St. N.W., Lower Level Room A-3, Washington, DC 20001**

Call to Order:

1. The monthly public meeting for Advisory Neighborhood Commission (ANC) 2C was called to order at 6:30 pm, by Commissioner John Tinpe, ANC-2C01. Commissioner Harold Closter, ANC-2C02 was also present. Commissioner Jeffrey J. Higgins, ANC-2C03, was unable to attend.

Quorum:

1. Commissioner Tinpe noted that two of the three Commissioners were present and that this constituted a quorum.

Approval of the Agenda:

1. Commissioner Closter moved to approve the agenda for the June 8, 2015 ANC-2C meeting. The motion was seconded and passed by a vote of 2-0.

Approval of May Meeting Minutes:

1. Commissioner Closter moved to approve the minutes from the ANC-2C monthly meeting that was held on May 11, 2015. The motion was seconded and passed by a vote of 2-0.

Treasurer's Report and Business Items:

1. Commissioner Closter presented the ANC-2C Treasurer's Report, indicating a current balance of \$31,942.12 at the end of May, 2015. The report showed that four checks totaling \$1,729.69 were paid during the month of May and that there were no outstanding checks. Commissioner Closter moved to approve the May 2015 Treasurer's Report. The motion was seconded and passed by a vote of 2-0.
1. Commissioner Tinpe noted a letter received from the Office of the District of Columbia Auditor authorizing the release of \$1,541.59 related to the 3rd Quarter FY 2015 Allotment.

Brief Community Announcement and Presentations:

1. Leslie Griffin, Administrative Librarian for Public Services, Martin Luther King Memorial Library introduced herself and gave a brief presentation on Adult Services at the library.

Local Events Impacting the Community:

1. Steve Winter presented plans for the **Race to End Women's Cancer**, scheduled for November 8, 2015. Commissioner Tinpe moved to approve the plan. The motion was seconded and passed by a vote of 2-0.
1. Ellen Getz presented plans for the **Medical Heroes Appreciation Walk**, scheduled for June 15, 2015. Commissioner Tinpe moved to approve the plan. The motion was seconded and passed by a vote of 2-0.
1. George Baker presented plans for the **Navy Mile on Pennsylvania Avenue**, scheduled for October 4, 2015. Commissioner Tinpe moved to approve the plan. The motion was seconded and passed by a vote of 2-0.

Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration Licensing

1. Andrew Kline presented a sidewalk café license application for **The National**, a Class "C" Restaurant located at 1100 Pennsylvania Ave., NW. Commissioner Tinpe requested that applicant modify the application to conform to existing neighborhood sidewalk café hours of service, namely, no later than 11:00 pm on Monday through Thursday, and no later than 12:00 am (midnight), on Friday through Sunday. The applicant agreed to these modifications. Commissioner Tinpe moved to approve the application with these modifications in place. The motion was seconded and passed by a vote of 2-0.
1. Andrew Kline presented a sidewalk café license application for **Pennsylvania 6**, a Class "C" restaurant located at 1350 Eye St. NW. Commissioner Tinpe requested that applicant modify the application to conform to existing neighborhood sidewalk café hours of service, namely, no later than 11:00 pm on Monday through Thursday, and no later than 12:00 am (midnight), on Friday through Sunday. The applicant agreed to these modifications. Commissioner Tinpe moved to approve the application with these modifications in place. The motion was seconded and passed by a vote of 2-0.

Transportation, Zoning and Public Space:

1. Maestro Restaurant, 1324 G. St., NW, presented a DDOT application for Valet parking, seven days a week, from 5:00 pm to 12:00 am (midnight). Commissioner Tinpe moved to approve the application. The motion was seconded and passed by a vote of 2-0.
