Local Events Impacting Community

1. Alum Run 2015, Sunday March 29, 2015. By Craig Dixon and Jeff Ruday.
Race to start at 8:30 am and end at 11 am. Streets cleared by 3:30 pm. Event to take place on Penn Ave between 13th and 14th Streets. Proceeds from the race to be donated to participants' universities, voluntary service food banks and DC Public Schools. Planned setting up to take place between 3 am and 7 am. ANC2C requested to set up before 12 midnight, in consideration for the hotel guests in the surrounding area.
ANC2C proposed a Motion to Support the Alum Race with the condition to set up before midnight on Saturday, March 28, 2015. Motion approved by 3 yeas and 0 nays.

1. Third Street Tunnel Update, by Shana Viera and Outreach Coordinator Bob Granoda.
Phase II of development/construction. Closures from December 8 to December 13th 2014.
Work hours: Mondays and Tuesdays from 7 am to midnight; Wednesdays, Thursdays and Fridays from 7 am to 3:30 pm; Saturdays from 8am to 6 pm.
