Alcohol Beverage Regulatory Licensing

1. Mastro's Steak House ABRA-096192 600 13th St NW, Application for a Retailer's Class C Restaurant license, by Steve O'Brien. Formerly M&S Grill, Mastro's will occupy 220 to 450 seats inside and 56 seats outside along F St. Hours of operation are 11 am to midnight on week days and 1 am on weekends. Application for Valet Parking will be submitted October 6, 2014. Motion to support: Approved by 3 years and 0 nays.

2. CAVA Mezze Grill, 707 H St NW, Application for a retailer's Class C Restaurant License, request for a stipulated license by Rosemarie Salguero. Hours of operation are from 11 am to 10 pm weekdays and to 11 pm on weekends. Occupying 2 floors and 42 seats. Motion to support: Approved by 3 years and 0 nays. 1. 1333 H St NW, Modification to an Addition of Existing Building, by Christine Roddy. Proposal to renovate façade and add new glass door which is transparent. Motion to support: Approved by 3 years and 0 nays.
2. 701 and 801 Penn Ave NW, Market Square, HPA 14-642 and 14-643, Concept Alteration to Entrances. To improve commercial entrances on 9th and 7th streets. Brass will be replaced by bronze. More glass exposure to bring more light. No historical preservation restrictions. Motion to approve: Approved by 3 years and 0 nays.

To commemorate President Kennedy's historic visit to West Berlin, a temporary loan from the City of Berlin, a 10 feet by 4 feet, a piece of the Berlin Wall, to be displayed in front of the building.
